

120 BUREAU OF FIRE PREVENTION

The Bureau of Fire Prevention is created pursuant to Chapter 76 of the Township of Florence Ordinances under the Board of Fire Commissioners of Florence Twp. Fire District No. 1, herein known as the "Bureau".

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Bureau shall be responsible for the enforcement of the Uniform Fire Safety Act (P.L. 1983, c. 383), the New Jersey Uniform Fire Code, and any other local codes pertaining to fire prevention that may be enacted by the Township of Florence, within the boundaries of the Township of Florence.
