

# **FLORENCE TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT NO.1**

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## **225 PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS**

### **PURPOSE:**

To establish the minimum service requirement levels for participation in the Florence Township Fire Department.

### **SCOPE:**

This policy is applicable to all levels of membership within the Department.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

All members of the Department are expected to participate in so far as they are capable.

Active members must complete a minimum of 40 hours of scheduled duty per month in order to be eligible for Incentive Program Awards as set forth in section 270 of the Policies and Procedures Manual of the Fire District. Members that do not meet the minimum participation standard shall not be eligible to receive payment as outlined.

Appointed Fire Line Officers must complete a minimum of 52 hours of scheduled duty per month in order to be eligible for Incentive Program Awards as set forth in section 270 of the Policies and Procedures Manual of the Fire District. Fire Line Officers that do not meet the minimum participation standard shall not be eligible to receive payment as outlined.

Active Fire Police members must complete a minimum of 50 hours of activity per year in order to be eligible for Incentive Program Awards as set forth in section 270 of the Policy and Procedures Manual of the Fire District. Fire Police members that do not meet the minimum participation standard shall not be eligible to receive payment as outlined.

Fire Police members that also participate in the Fire Duty Crew Program, will be required to meet the eligibility for active members as listed above.

Scheduled hours will be in accordance with Section 216 of the Policies and Procedures Manual of the Fire District.

In order to maintain Active status, a minimum of 30 hours per month activity must be completed. If duty time is not scheduled as a part of the Fire Duty Crew Program as set forth in section 216 of the Policies and Procedures Manual of the Fire District, hours will be accumulated based upon that members combined participation in all Fire Department Activities. Time credited for Non Incident Activities must be approved by the Chief of Department or his Designee.

Exceptions to the minimums may be granted by the Chief of Department after review of the specific circumstances.

Members not meeting the minimum standards as outlined within this section may have their Active status suspended or revoked.
