RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE NEWSPAPERS IN WHICH ALL PUBLIC NOTICES FOR THE FLORENCE TWP. FIRE DISTRICT NO. 1 WILL BE TRANSMITTED

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of New Jersey enacted into law the "Open Public Meeting Law", P.L. 1975 c 231 (Sunshine Law) to take effect January 1, 1976 requiring all meetings of public bodies be at all times except under limited circumstances as specifically provided for therein; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the newspapers named hereafter are those most likely to inform the people of Florence Township of any public meetings of this body, and shall here within be designated the two newspapers to which all public notices required by the Sunshine Law may be transmitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Florence Twp. Fire District No. 1 that:

- 1. The Trenton Times and the Burlington County Times are hereby designated as the two newspapers that all public notices may be transmitted to by the Secretary or Administrative staff.
